TARGA FLORIO

(1969, 1970, 1971 & 1972)

International Championship for Makes

This event will have overlap with Scratch32 SP, CP & 3LM classes but will limit models to those that participated in the 1969 through 1972 Targa Florio races. Participants will include models that finished, started, practiced or were at minimum registered to race in either years' event. The purpose in opening up the definition of 'participant' in this manner is to accommodate as many models as one might have an opportunity to scratch build - NOT to accommodate ready to run bodies or models that are easy to obtain.

No 'master list' of eligible models or entries will be provided since it is easy enough to find much of this information freely on the internet. Do some research first and then ask if you have questions. It is expected that you share with the group some of the history of the models that you build and present.

Models in any 'class' that raced in those years are eligible. Combining all years there look to be 14 classes of eligible entries: five 'P', five 'S' and four 'GT'. Several classes have a motor restriction as defined in the table below.

Models must be modified or be representative in look to the entry upon which they purport to be based. Just how far one goes to achieve this is not for anyone else to decide – your own pride and building ability should be your guide. That being said, there will be a minimum threshold that every model is expected to meet otherwise the purpose of this event will be lost. Fantasy liveries are not permitted. Actual racing numbers are to be used although alternative numbers in the same font/style may be substituted if one wishes. Consult prior Targa events and/or the Scratch32 Model Database to review which liveries have already been used. Make sure to list your models within the specific registration topic for the Targa event you are entering. This will alert others and help avoid duplicates from being registered. Please also complete our online Scratch32 Model Entry Form for all NEW models or models that have been CHANGED.

This event will repeat at least once in every future Scratch32 season (comprised of four months) so unfinished efforts will always have another 'day'.

Race format will be disclosed close in time to the event but it will not involve heats exceeding 5 minutes nor back to back rotations without sufficient breaks.

Building and registering multiple models for each Targa event is encouraged and those that do will have an opportunity to race all of them, time permitting of course.

TO SUMMARIZE:

- 1. Eligible models any Targa Florio participants between 1969 through 1972, including Finishers, Starters, those that Practiced OR those Entered/Registered regardless of class;
- 2. Actual liveries ONLY but number may be changed provided same font/type used;
- 3. Motor Restrictions Class of entry determines the fastest motor that may be used for every model as defined in the chart below;
- 4. Chassis or body must be scratch built painted 'white kits' are insufficient; and
- 5. All General Rules for Scratch32 apply.
